

HOUSE BILL 1030: 2016 Appropriations Act, Sec. 20.2: Study Creation of North Military Hall of Fame.

OVERVIEW: Sec. 20.2 of S.L. 2016-94 directs the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to study the feasibility of creating a North Carolina Military Hall of Fame, and to report its findings to the chairs of the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on General Government by November 1, 2016.

This section became effective July 1, 2016.

BILL ANALYSIS: Sec. 20.2 of the act directs the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to study the feasibility of creating a North Carolina Hall of Fame to recognize the contributions to the State and nation by members of the military with connections to North Carolina.

The Department is required to submit its report to the chairs of the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on General Government by November 1, 2016. The Department's report is to address all of the following:

- The feasibility and desirability of creating a North Carolina Military Hall of Fame.
- Its potential locations.
- Its projected costs and potential offsetting revenue streams associated with it.
- Recommendations regarding its administrative structure.
- Potential processes for selecting members for inclusion in the Military Hall of Fame.
- Methods for ensuring participation in its operation by active and reserve components of the military.
- Other matters deemed relevant by the Department.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section of the act became effective July 1, 2016.
