

## SENATE BILL 99: Appropriations Act of 2018, Sec. 11F.1: Single-Stream Funding for Mental Health/Developmental Disabilities/Substance Abuse Services Community Services

OVERVIEW: Section 11F.1 of S.L. 2018-5 amends section 11F.2(b) of S.L. 2017-57 to require the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, Department of Health and Human Services, to reduce its allocation for single-stream funding in the 2018-19 fiscal year by \$36,440,895 in recurring funds and by \$71,189,458 in nonrecurring funds. The reductions originally called for in section 11F.2(b) of S.L. 2017-57 were \$36,002,854 in recurring funds and \$54,605,823 in nonrecurring funds.

This section became effective July 1, 2018.
