OVERVIEW: Sec. 16.3 of S.L. 2018-5 exempts the Samarcand Training Academy from the requirement that all State agencies transfer all passenger motor vehicles under their ownership, custody or control to the ownership, custody or control of the Department of Administration.

This section became effective on July 1, 2018.

CURRENT LAW: All State agencies must transfer all passenger motor vehicles under their ownership, custody or control to the ownership, custody or control of the Department of Administration except those under the ownership, custody or control of the Highway Patrol, the State Bureau of Investigation, or the constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina, which are used primarily for law-enforcement purposes.

BILL ANALYSIS: Sec. 16.3 of S.L. 2018-5 exempts the Samarcand Training Academy from the requirement to transfer its passenger motor vehicles to ownership, custody or control of the Department of Administration.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective on July 1, 2018.

BACKGROUND: Located in Moore County, the Samarcand Training Academy is the Department of Public Safety's law enforcement training facility.
