

## **SENATE BILL 99:** Appropriations Act of 2018, Sec. 7.13: Extend Pilot/Virtual Charter Schools.

OVERVIEW: Sec. 7.13 of S.L. 2018-5 extends the pilot program for two virtual charter schools for an additional four years. The pilot was scheduled to end in 2018-2019, and is extended to the 2022-2023 school year. Reports on findings from the pilot program by the State Board of Education to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee are also extended, with a report on findings from five years of operation of the pilot program due by November 15, 2020, and a report on findings from seven years of operation of the pilot program due by November 15, 2022.

This section became effective July 1, 2018.
