**OVERVIEW:** *House Bill 262 would designate the City of Brevard, the Town of Rosman, and Transylvania County as North Carolina's official land of waterfalls.*

**CURRENT LAW:** State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official land of waterfalls.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** This act would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding a new section to designate the City of Brevard, the Town of Rosman, and Transylvania County as North Carolina's official land of waterfalls.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would become effective when it becomes law.
